Day 01: Arrival in Cape Town (D) (The Cape Milner Hotel)

Arrival at the Cape Town International Airport, you will be met by your guide and transferred to the Cape Milner Hotel for check-in. Depending on arrival time, spend the day exploring Cape Town and the Waterfront. Cape Town is regarded as one of the most visited destinations in the world with its Table Mountain, Cape Peninsula, Kirstenbosch Gardens and world renown winelands.

Day 02: Milnerton Golf Course (B, D) (The Cape Milner Hotel)

An early start this morning with a drive out to the Milnerton Links Golf Club. The Milnerton Golf Course is an 18-hole par 72 course of 6101 meters making for a challenging coastal course. Rated 5 stars in 2013 for design, condition, service and facilities, the course is not only 10 minutes for the Cape Town CBD but most holes hug the Atlantic Sea and lagoon.

Enjoy the Milnerton Golf course for most of the day before enjoying Cape Town in the afternoon at leisure.

Day 03: The Cape Peninsula (B, D) (The Cape Milner Hotel)

Today we will explore the beautiful Cape Peninsula. We will drive to Hout Bay where you have an option to walk around to view the arts and crafts on the Harbor. We will then proceed to drive over the scenic Chapman's Peak drive to Cape Point/Cape of Good Hope.

At Cape Point you can walk or take a vanicular to the top lighthouse to view the Cape Peninsula. Leaving the Cape Peninsula, we make our way to Boulders to the Penguin colony where we can view the African Penguins.

Day 04: Clovelly Golf Course (B, D) (The Cape Milner Hotel)

Clovelly Golf course, situated on the Cape Peninsula with spectacular views over False bay and Silvermine Rivers makes for a perfect start to your golfing tour of South Africa. Clovelly Golf Course offers a tight par 72, elevated greens and interesting fairways with natural water features all the while soaking in the spectacular scenery.

Late afternoon visit to the Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens makes for a well rounded first day of golf.

Day 05: Cape Winelands (B, D) (LaFontaine Boutique Guest House)

The Cape Winelands is regarded Internationally as one of the best wine producers in the world and spending the day traversing Stellenbosch, Franschhoek and Paarl is an experience to be remembered. Taste wines, cheeses and many other delights the area has to offer before returning late afternoon to our Boutique Guest House in the heart of Franschhoek.

Day 06: Franschhoek to George (B, D) (Fancourt Manor House) (430km)

The tour departs the mother city this morning heading east over Sir Lowry's pass and through the small towns of Caledon and Swellendam arriving at Mossel Bay late afternoon. After a late lunch, make time to visit the Diaz museum before continuing to our hotel at the Fancourt Golf Club a short distance from the small town of George.

On every safari to Southern Africa, it is essential to know what to pack and that you pack the correct gear to avoid any mishaps while on tour. Below is a guideline to some of the basic requirements.

Please remember to **NOT** pack your gear into hard cover suitcases as this is difficult to carry around and could get damaged. It's also very important to limit your luggage to the below weight limits.

Your Luggage should consist of

- One large kit bag
- No hard suitcases (max. weight =20 kg (44 lbs))
- One item of hand luggage (e.g. a small backpack)

- Passport (must be valid at least another 6 months from date of entry)
- Torch with spare batteries and globes
- Hat/Cap
- Warm Jacket
- Swimming Costume
- Natural Clothing (i.e. No bright colours)
- A pair of light weight long pants and a lightweight long sleeve shirt (to use against the sun)
- Comfortable walking shoes and strops/sandals
- Camera Equipment, Binoculars, and lots of spare memory cards & batteries
- Water bottle

Toiletries for Luxury Safaris to Southern Africa

- Personal Toiletries in small bag, not a vanity case
- Suntan Lotion and block out for the face
- Malaria Prophylaxis. (Northern Namibia, Botswana and Kruger National Park)
- Mosquito repellent lotion/spray

Important Information

The below important information is for each traveller to read through and to understand before arriving on your African safari. Please contact Adventour consultants should there be any queries.

Insurance (Compulsory)

All travellers booking a safari to Southern Africa must have adequate medical insurance. This is compulsory as activity providers on safari may refuse participation of activities without proper insurance in place. Should you not have medical insurance you may be required to pay cash before being airlifted should this become necessary.

Health

Please note that we need to be informed of any pre-existing health conditions such as diabetes or asthma or any other condition that requires prescription medicine. Please note that Adventour or any of its travel partners will not be held liable or responsible for damage or loss to such medication and the safe keeping of such medication must be looked after by its respective user.

Diet Requirements

For Adventour and its travel partners to properly cater whilst on tour, it is important to inform us at the point of booking should there be any special dietary requirement.

Visas

As visa requirements vary considerably from country to country and nationality to nationality, please contact the various embassies or a visa service agent in your home country to re-check your visa requirements at least 4 weeks prior to travelling.

Please note that visas are the responsibility of the traveller and that Adventour or its partners will not be held responsible for guests being denied entry should they not be in the possession of the relevant visas.

PLEASE NOTE: Should the adventure tour you are joining be re-entering a country, be sure to have a multiple entry visa that enables you to re-enter the country.

All travellers must be in possession of a valid onward/return air ticket or proof of other means of transport enabling the traveller to leave the country in which your adventure tour passes or terminates. You should also have proof of sufficient funds (e.g. credit card) to see you through your time in the country.

Covid-19 Travel Regulations

- ✓ All arriving tourists will arrive with a negative Covid-19 PCR test valid not older than 72 hours and issued by a certified laboratory.
- ✓ All arriving tourists will have a confirmed detailed itinerary in hand to submit to authorities.
- ✓ Upon arrival at the OR Tambo International Airport, King Shaka International Airport or Cape Town International Airport, tourists will be screened. Those presenting symptoms will be required to take a Covid test.
- ✓ If necessary, tourists will need to enter mandatory quarantine facility at own cost

- ✓ Travel may be restricted from high risk countries
- ✓ Face masks must be worn at all times.
